# **EUCF - Why?**

Lack of capacity in municipalities

Lack of culture and engagement with financial sector

funding or financing sources

Difficult to find the best

Absence of 'easy' national support

Competition in local budgets

Missing link between strategy and implementation

> Difficulty of matching elections and investment cycles

Difficulty to combine different funding sources and align funding programmes with cities' needs

#### D-Click Brussels

**Objective:** Contribute to the energy neutrality for public buildings by 2040 -Brussels-Capital Region's Sustainable Energy and Climate Action Plan

#### **EUCF** project D-Click Brussels

- Scope: local public buildings in the Brussels-Capital Region (RBC)
  - o Mainly offices, schools, nurseries, nursing homes, workshops, cultural & sports centres
  - o Focus on global, ambitious, sustainable & exemplary renovations to reduce energy consumption by min 35%
- EUCF grant: finance a Project Manager-led mission to develop the Investment Concept (IC)
  - o On basis of 6 tracks: business model, finances, data & projects, purchasing, processes & tools, communication

#### Expected values by 2040

331.45 GWh/y Energy savings

13 GWh/y Renewable energy production

60.916 tons/year **Avoided CO2 emissions** 

**1,069 million** € **investment size** for 305 buildings









#### Governance

- Regional Minister of Energy + Regional Environment & Energy Agency
- The 19 municipalities (Schaerbeek coordinating)
- Inter-municipal cooperative SIBELGA, the operator of electricity & gas distribution networks in the Brussels-Capital Region, with other missions regarding energy transition facilitation in BCR

# The IC served as basis for RenoClick program = a building renovation one-stop shop set up by Sibelga in March 2022

#### Services offered by Renoclick

- Support to Brussels municipalities in selecting the best projects and defining technical solutions
- Energy consumption monitoring (SCAN software)
- Central purchasing organization for procurement (studies and public works)
- Fundraising & grants facilitation
- Project results & energy savings monitoring









## Main dimensions of renovation projects

#### Deep energy retrofits in public buildings

- Building envelope (insulation, window frames,...) (new challenge for Sibelga)
- HVAC systems (previous experience with the Sibelga NRClick program)
- Renewable energy (previous experience with the Sibelga SolarClick program)

#### Progress report (October 2023):

- 56 buildings audited
- 21 buildings formalizing the commitment of the competent authorities to finance a "deep renovation" project
- Facilitation to help municipalities access regional "Renoclick" grant (available in 2022 & 2023 partly funded by EU Recovery and Resilience Facility) and "FEDER" EU program (2021-2027)
- Central purchasing organization set up since January 2022 Framework contract for study missions (available since April 2023) and for public works (available spring 2024)
- 15 project concretely started with procurement fase for architect's study mission









#### Financing

Direct funding by 19 municipalities in BCR (incl. Schaerbeek)

#### Other public investors/grants

- Region & Community authorities
- European funds (ex. RRF, ERDF,...)
- > Ex. : Grant RenoClick = BCR regional grant supported by RRF
